Youth Board Representative

The Youth Board Representative is a new initiative to expand voices and representation on our Board of Directors. The Youth Board Representative will attend all board meetings (virtual; approximately 6 per year) and provide insight and guidance on the direction and governance of the choir as a non-profit organization.

Ideal candidates will have a background in choral music and previous leadership experience with community or campus organizations/clubs. The position is ideal for someone interested in gaining experience working with non-profit organizations and community leadership.

Note that applicants to the Assistant Conductor and Choral Scholar positions can be considered for this role as well.
